

## MEMBERSHIP ANNUAL DECLARATIONS AND UNDERTAKINGS

CFP® Professional, Financial Planner AFP® and Associate membership categories

By applying for membership renewal I agree that:

- a. I am not aware of any finding, conduct or event, which would affect my fitness to hold FPA membership, or my eligibility to hold membership in the CFP® Professional/Financial Planner AFP® and Associate subcategory;
- b. I have disclosed in this form or previously to the FPA all matters and all current contact details necessary for the FPA to maintain any public Register of members;
- c. I am a fit and proper person to be a member of the FPA;
- d. I am in good standing with my Australian Financial Services Licensee (where relevant); and
- e. I undertake to the Board:
- to comply with the <u>Constitution</u> of the FPA including any regulations made by the Board from time to time, including the:
  - 1. <u>Member and Affiliate Regulation (2020)</u> (as amended by the Board of FPA from time to time);
  - FPA Disciplinary Regulation (2019) (as amended by the Board of FPA from time to time), including without limitation the disciplinary proceedings for members;
  - 3. Regulation 02/04- use of the FPA brand by members, including without limitation of the use of CERTIFIED FINANCIAL PLANNER®, CFP®, Financial Planner AFP® trademarks and associated logos;
  - 4. FPA Code of Professional Practice (FPA Code) as amended from time to time;
  - 5. <u>FPA Continuing Professional Development Policy</u> as amended from time to time;
- ii. to remain a fit and proper person;
- iii. to notify the FPA within 28 days of the effective date of:
  - 1. any change of address, email, telephone and other contact details;
  - 2. any change of employment details or change of status as a Financial Advice Representative of an Australian Financial Services Licensee;
  - any other finding, conduct or event, which would affect my fitness to hold FPA membership, to belong to a certain sub-category (as the case may be), or be necessary for the FPA to maintain any public Register;
- to provide notice in writing to the FPA within seven (7) days of the occurrence of any Notifiable Event; and
- v. to submit to any complaints and disciplinary investigation, and compliance reviews if required by the FPA pursuant to clauses 18 or 19 of the FPA Constitution.

  - i. I consent to the FPA disclosing the fact that I hold membership to any person (whether upon request or by publication) notwithstanding that such information may compromise
